Show Rules:

- 1. All entries are free and are open to financial members of the Cymbidium Club of Australia Inc.**
- 2. Although there will be security at the show, entries are received on the basis that neither the Cymbidium Club of Australia Inc and Swanes Nursery Carlingford shall be held responsible for any damage, destruction or loss to such entries and the exhibitor shall have no claim whatsoever against the Club or its sponsors.**
- 3. Plants competing for prizes shall have been owned and in the possession of the exhibitor for the proceeding six months.**
- 4. All plants must be healthy and free from pests and diseases. The show Marshall of the committee may reject any plant for any reason and request that they be removed from the venue. Their decision is final.**
- 5. All plants and pots must be clean.**
- 6. The show Marshall or committee reserves the right to reject, remove or rearrange any exhibit.**
- 7. All plants must be labeled correctly.**
- 8. Judging will be in accordance with the standards and by-laws of the Cymbidium Club of Australia Inc., The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.**
- 9. An exhibitor shall not remove plants before the end of the show without the prior permission of the Show Marshall.**
- 10. Entries in the seedling classes must be nominated to the show Marshall prior to the commencement of Judging.**
- 11. A seedling shall mean the complete plant grown from seed and being shown for its first flowering season. Plants that have been divided are not eligible to be shown as seedlings.**
- 12. The Cymbidium Club committee reserves the right to photograph plants and flowers for its own purposes**
- 13. If in the opinion of the Judges, no exhibit in a class warrants a prize, none shall be awarded.**
- 14. Staking shall be in accordance with the rules of the Cymbidium Club of Australia Inc. ie. Flowers may be supported in the best possible manner for presentation. This support should be in a manner so as not to be obtrusive and distract from the overall beauty of the plant. If it is necessary to tie above the bottom flower or top branch, the Judges are permitted to penalize or remove the such tie for the purpose of judging.**

Keith Harris showed the new Dural Show cards.

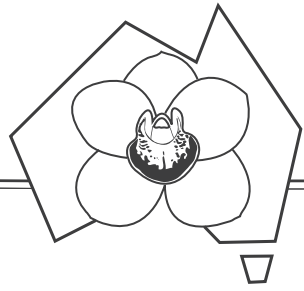
After supper Peter Moore presented a slide show on the 2011 Taiwan International Orchid Show.

2011 NATIONAL ORCHID EXTRAVAGANZA RULES

1. Exhibitors must be affiliated members of an Orchid Society.
2. All plants must have been owned and grown by the exhibitor for a minimum of six (6) months.
3. Each plant must have the correctly spelt name of the plant on a business size card (90mm x 55mm) or equivalent.
4. A seedling is the whole plant raised from seed, which has not been divided and is being shown for the first time during its current flowering season.
5. All notifiable classes should be registered at the marshal's desk by **11.30 am Thursday, 11th August** to receive the appropriate identification tag (cymbidiums only).
6. **All benching to be completed by 11.30 am, as judging will commence shortly thereafter.**
7. The Show Marshals are authorised to reject any exhibit.
8. All care and reasonable caution for the safety and security of exhibits will be exercised. No responsibility for loss, damage or destruction to any such exhibits will be accepted by the Cymbidium Club of Australia Inc, the Show Committee or the Sponsors, and any exhibitor will have no claim whatsoever against the sponsors or any of the clubs involved.
9. If in the judge's opinion, any exhibit in any class does not warrant a prize, then the prize will not be given. All judge's decisions will be **FINAL**.
10. The Cymbidium Club of Australia Inc, reserves the right to photograph any exhibit for its own purposes or for publication in any form.
11. Once staged, no entry may be removed without the permission of the Show Marshal.
12. Prizes will be in the form of cheques, ribbons/rosettes, trophies as per show schedule.
13. All plants **MUST** be in show bench condition.
14. One bloom per clone per exhibitor (i.e.; 1 of Lovely Angel "Bubbles", 1 of Coco Jim 'Starquest' etc)
15. Displays are eligible to win only one category prize.
16. Cut stems, one spike per clone, per exhibitor (i.e. ; 1 of Khan Flame "Baroness", 1 of Khan Flame "Roberta", 1 of Khan Flame 'Raquel', 1 of Khan Flame "Fat Boy" etc etc.)
17. Cut stems and bloom cymbidiums are **NOT** eligible for Grand Champion or Reserve Champion.
18. When staging a floral display the exhibit must be ORCHID flowers only. Embellishments are allowable as long as it does not contain other flowers (Wattle, Strelitzia etc etc)

19. Ultra miniatures will be judged under the same rules as miniature flowers and the flower size will be up to 35mm and must be judged as appreciation only

20. **CYMBIDIUMS WILL BE JUDGED IN DISPLAYS AND TABLE TOPS BUT MUST BE NOMINATED. ALL OTHER GENERA WILL ONLY BE JUDGED ON BENCHES AND OTHER GENERA USED FOR DISPLAY WILL NOT BE ENTITLED TO BE JUDGED, (I.E. IF YOU HAVE 2 CATTLEYS FOR EXHIBITING THEN YOU CHOOSE THE BETTER ONE FOR JUDGING, WHICH WILL REMAIN FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW ON THE BENCH AND THE OTHER CAN BE USED IN YOUR DISPLAY).**

21. To be eligible as a specimen plant the following stem count must be adhered to;
