GENERAL MEETING MINUTES HELD AT THE ALLAN G. EZZY COMMUNITY CENTRE ON 11 May 2023

President Geoff Le Marne opened the meeting at 8pm.

The usual prize money will be on offer at the Winter and Spring shows.

Ken Wynn had brought in a plant with fasciatum where the spike was caught up in the sheath. It is an occasional deformity which can occur for no reason. If caught early, the spike can be released by cutting the surrounding tissue.

Judith Brooks informed the meeting that organisation for the National Orchid Extravaganza is well underway. Unfortunately the fliers for the show will not be available to Members until next month. Everyone is encouraged to take some to distribute to local nurseries, florists and the general public in their area – even the local Clubs (RSL, Bowling, etc) may be willing to take some to put out for their Members. The more we can get the word out about the Show, the better turnout we can expect.

Geoff had brought in his EC meter, used for measuring the strength of some fertilizers (not urea levels). The readings from the EC meter can easily be converted to ppm (parts per million). There are always questions amongst growers as to what EC level is ideal, with differing opinions. The plants have different requirements from winter to summer, depending on the growth phase the plant is in, spike production and lengthening and so on.

If you are interested in checking your fertilizer EC level, get in touch with Geoff and bring in a sample for him to check.

He also had a pH meter, which is somewhat more difficult to use and care for. General discussion on fertilizer regimens ensued.

The meeting broke for supper at 8.30pm and resumed at 8.50pm.

Seong Tay presented on his lab flasking operations and covered subjects such as sewing seed and replating and growing on your seedlings to compots and individual pots.

As mentioned at the last meeting, the fliers for the Extravaganza will be available at the June meeting for everyone to take. Please do help out with the Show's promotion. This is good for the Club and also supports the vendors who travel from far and wide to help us make the Show a success.
