Show Conditions

- ✚ Exhibitors **must be** affiliated members of an Orchid Society.
- ✚ **All plants must have been owned and grown by the exhibitor for a minimum of six (6) months.**
- ✚ Each exhibit must have the name of the plant **correctly printed** on the business size card supplied.
- ✚ **'Seedling'** shall mean the complete plant grown from seed and flowered for the first time. Plants that have been grown on or divided prior to being exhibited on the show bench are not eligible to be shown as seedlings. For exhibition purposes seedlings shall retain their status of 'Seedling' throughout the flowering season in which they first flower. Mericlones **are not** eligible as seedlings. **For clarity, 'seedling' will apply, at this show, to hybrids only.**
- ✚ **All nominated classes** must be registered with the Show Marshal by **11.30 am Thursday, 8th August** to receive the appropriate identification tag (cymbidiums only).
- ✚ **All benching to be completed by 11.30 am, as judging will commence shortly thereafter.**
- ✚ The Show Marshals are authorised to reject any exhibit.
- ✚ All care and reasonable caution for the safety and security of exhibits will be exercised. No responsibility for loss, damage or destruction to any such exhibits will be accepted by the Cymbidium Club of Australia Inc, the Show Committee or the Sponsors, and any exhibitor will have no claim whatsoever against the sponsors or any of the clubs involved.
- ✚ If in the judge's opinion, any exhibit in any class does not warrant a prize, then the prize will not be given. **All judge's decisions will be FINAL.**
- ✚ The Cymbidium Club of Australia Inc, reserves the right to photograph any exhibit for its own purposes or for publication in any form.
- ✚ **Once staged, no entry may be removed prior to the completion of the show, without the permission of the Show Marshal.**

- ✚ Prizes will be in the form of ribbons/rosettes, trophies as per show schedule.
- ✚ All plants **MUST** be in show bench condition.
- ✚ One bloom per clone per exhibitor (i.e. 1 of Lovely Angel 'Bubbles', 1 of Coco Jim 'Starquest' etc)
- ✚ Bloom cymbidiums are **NOT** eligible for Grand Champion or Reserve Champion
- ✚ Exhibits are eligible to win only one category prize
- ✚ **When staging a floral display the exhibit must only contain ORCHID flowers.** Embellishments are allowable as long as it does not contain other types of flowers (eg. Wattle, Strelitzia, etc)
- ✚ Ultra miniatures will be judged under the same rules as miniatures flowers and the flower size will be up to 35mm.
- ✚ To be eligible as a specimen plant the following stem count must be adhered to;

Standard Cymbidiums	4 spikes
Small Standard Cymbidiums	4 spikes
Intermediate Cymbidiums	5 spikes
Miniature Cymbidiums	6 spikes

✚ **Definition of a pot plant for this show**

The **whole undivided plant** should be benched in **no larger than a 200mm pot.**

It will **ideally be compact in growth and its floriflorousness must be commensurate** with the size of the plant. The flower should be attractive, distinctly/brightly coloured, have a well balanced shape and be displayed on a strong upright raceme.

- ✚ Members wishing to sell on the club table must ensure they have paid the current membership dues before Wednesday, August 7th.
- ✚ The commission charged by the Society for the sale of member's plants will be 15% from those members who provide a minimum of 4 hours supervision at the venue and have plants entered into the Show for judging, or 20% from members who do not attend for the required length of time and/or have not entered plants into the Show for judging. The supervision required to avoid the extra commission will not include the day of set up or the day of dismantling. Please ensure that you sign on and off in the attendance book at the club table and report to the show marshals (Nat or David) at that time.
